The Lord be with you.

I go to verse 16 in Jeremiah 6. "This is what the Lord says." This is what the Lord says, America, listen up. "The Lord says, stand at the crossroads and look ask for the ancient paths. And today as we stand at the crossroads ask where the good way is, the good way is set for us in scripture ask where the good way is, and walking it, do it. And here's the promise, that if we do that, you will find rest for your souls.

I sense that God has been trying to get America's attention for some time, we are broken, we are shattered, and people may be saying it's not so bad, we'll be just fine, they dress the wounds of the people as to, we're not serious, but it is serious. Would you join with me and praying for our nation, and let us join with many others and praying a prayer by the late Billy Graham that he prayed in 2001.

"Our Father and our God, we praise you for your goodness to our nation, giving us blessings far beyond what we deserve, yet we know all is not right with America, we deeply need a moral and spiritual renewal to help us meet the many problems we face, convict us of sin, help us to turn to you and repentance and faith, set our feet on the path of your righteousness and peace.
